DIRECTIONS TO CAMP NORGE

From Sacramento, take I-80 East to Alta exit (exit 146). At stop sign, turn RIGHT. Go to end of road (about two blocks) and turn LEFT. Go about a block (the road forks) and turn RIGHT (up the hill). Follow the Sons of Norway signs. From Reno, take I-80 West to Alta exit (exit 146). At the stop sign, turn LEFT, go under the freeway and follow directions above. Camp Norge is only 1/2 mile from the freeway.

FACILITIES

MAIN HOUSE: A full kitchen has cooking and eating utensils provided. The living room has a television, fireplace and piano. The two dining room areas can seat 6 to 12 in each room.

SOCIAL HALL: Seats up to 60 for dining at folding tables and chairs. Separate kitchen with commercial stove, refrigerators and freezer. Cooking utensils and dishes are available. There is adequate space for dancing when tables and chairs are folded.

TWO BATH FACILITIES: One is located on the upper level across from the Barn and Social Hall, the other is located in the meadow to accommodate RVs and Tent Campers. These provide showers and toilets for men and women.

MEADOW: This large and beautiful area includes RV and Tent Camping, water and electricity only. There is room for volleyball, soccer or other group games on the lawn. The fire pit is ideal for evening gatherings. Picnic tables are located throughout the camping and lawn areas.

HORSESHOE PITS: Two regulation size pits. Horseshoes are available.

SWIMMING POOL AND PLAYGROUND: The 46-foot pool and playground equipment are fun for the children.

BARBECUE PIT: Located on the lawn near the social hall, it is ideal for large groups.

ACCOMMODATIONS

MAIN HOUSE: (Members Only) Three bedrooms and a bathroom above the first floor common area, sleeping up to 12.

DORM 1: Two story building, 6 bedrooms, sleeping up to 25 (some double, single and bunk beds). On the lower level of the building, there is a men's and women's bathroom, with showers.

DORM 2: Single story building, 4 bedrooms, sleeping 8 in twin beds. Bathroom facility located in Dorm 1 next door.

THE BARN: One large room with 6 single beds. Bathroom facilities located across side lawn area.

CABINS: Small cabins with covered porch, two twin beds. Located below Dorm 2. Restrooms in Dorm 1 or Meadow bathroom. Picnic tables and water faucets for outdoor eating.

Persons using the sleeping accommodations must bring their bedding, pillows, towels, toiletries and food. Cooking facilities are available in the main house. Or bring your camping gear for outdoor cooking, picnic tables are available near all buildings.

Camp Norge is operated by and for the members of District Six, Sons of Norway. It is governed by the Board of Directors who are elected by District Six members.

The Dorm rooms, Camping area and Social Hall are available for groups sponsored by a Sons of Norway member. Call for details.
